Hardware Eurasia 2025 has Opened Its Doors in Istanbul

The International Hardware Eurasia Fair, officially opened its doors for the fourth time on April 9, 2025, in Istanbul. Held at Tüyap Fair and Congress Center, the event brings together over 10,000 industry professionals from 75 countries, paving the way for new business collaborations in the hardware sector. As one of the most significant gathering points for the hardware industry in Eurasia, Hardware Eurasia 2025 is being organized simultaneously with Tube Eurasia and Wire Eurasia from April 9 to 12 at Tüyap Fair and Congress Center in Istanbul. These meetings will provide a crucial platform for local manufacturers seeking to expand their export potential.

On **April 11**, the **HISİAD Academy Seminars** will take place, where **industry experts** will share insights on the latest market trends, innovations, and sector developments.
